RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1. OPENING TIMES:** The Show will open at 7.30 am.
- 2. ARRIVAL OF DOGS:** Dogs will be received at any time but it is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure that exhibits are available for judging when required.
- 3. JUDGING TIME:** Judging will commence at 9am (Border Terriers 8.30am) unless otherwise notified in the dog press.
- 4. SHOW CLOSURES:** Exhibits may be removed from the show after their judging has been completed. Exhibits may not be removed any earlier unless by written order of the Veterinary Surgeon, Veterinary Practitioner or of the Show Management and then only in very exceptional and unforeseen circumstances which must be reported to the Kennel Club. The Show will close half an hour after all judging has been completed by which time dogs must be removed.
- 5. COOKING STOVES:** The use of cooking stoves in the proximity of tenting and benching areas is forbidden except as authorised by the Show Management.
- 6. ENTRY AND OTHER FEES:** The **entry fee for each dog** belonging to a breed **with** CCs on offer is £19.00 and **without** CCs on offer £10.00. **Subsequent Breed entries** with the same dog are £1.00. and **Stakes Classes** £3.00.
Please note: With the exception of the Y.K.C. Members who may enter the Y.K.C Members Stakes as a first class at £6.00 without going in the breed, all exhibits must be entered in a Breed class before entering any of the stakes classes.
Dogs entered "**Not for Competition** £10.00 may not be entered in any classes whatsoever, but a bench will be provided for them.
Prepaid Catalogues 3.00 (3.50 on the day.)
Admission to visitors free of charge.
Please make cheques payable to the **National Terrier Club.**
Caravans are allowed on the ground Friday to Sunday inclusive.
Please note: Caravan parking fees will be collected on site by a representative of the Bingley Hall and not paid with entries.
- 7. PRIZE MONEY:** The amount of prize money on offer at this show is:
Prize Money in the Members , Veteran and Special Beginners Stakes will be: 1st - £4, 2nd - £2.50, 3rd - £1 in each class.
Prize Money in the *Purina Pro Plan/Dog World Pup of the Year 2009 competition* will be: -
1st - £5, 2nd - £4, 3rd - £3, 4th - £2. 5th - £1 with an extra £20 to the outright winner, £15 to the 1st runner up, £10 to the 2nd runner up and £5 to the 3rd runner up.
Please Note: *Dogs which have already qualified for the Purina Pro Plan/Dog World "Pup of the Year" final are not eligible to compete.*
Prize Money in the Y.K.C Stakes class will be: 1st - £5, 2nd - £3, 3rd - £2.
- 8. REFUSAL OF ENTRIES:** The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
- 9. PUPPIES:** Puppies under six calendar months of age on the first day of the Show are not eligible for exhibition.
- 10. MATING OF BITCHES:** The mating of bitches within the precincts of the Show is forbidden
- 11. BEST PUPPY IN SHOW:** Where a Best Puppy in Show competition is scheduled the Best Puppy in Show is a puppy which has competed and is unbeaten by any other puppy exhibited at the same show. A puppy is a dog of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show. Where the Best of Breed or Best in Show is a puppy it will also automatically be Best Puppy in Breed and Best Puppy in Show respectively. Similarly, if the Reserve Best of Breed or Reserve Best in Show is a puppy which has only been beaten by an adult dog it will also automatically be Best Puppy in Breed or Best Puppy in Show respectively. Consequently, selection of Best Puppy in Breed and Best Puppy in Show must follow the selection of Best of Breed and Best in Show respectively.
 - a. Championship Shows Judged on the Group System**
 - (1) Best Puppy in Breed**
A Best Puppy must be declared in each breed from puppies entered in the Breed Classes.
 - (2) Best Puppy in Group** - Best Puppy in Group and subsequent Puppy Group placing must be selected from:
 - (a)** Those puppies declared Best Puppy in Breed provided they are unbeaten by any other puppy.
 - (b)** The Puppy declared Best Puppy from the Any Variety Not Separately Classified classes provided it is unbeaten by any other puppy.

Rules & Regs Contd.

11. Contd.

- b. Withdrawal from Competition:** Puppies which become eligible for Best Puppy in Show may be withdrawn from all other competition, other than breed classes & Best Puppy in Breed, prior to the competition for Best Puppy in Show as appropriate, in order to remain unbeaten. A puppy beaten in competition for Best Puppy in Show may subsequently be exhibited in all competition for which it was previously eligible. The dog declared Best Puppy In Show, however, must not compete in any subsequent competition.
Puppies may be withdrawn from Any Variety classes when judged before Breed Classes.
- c. Proviso.** For the purpose of this Regulation, dogs beaten in competition for Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Progeny, Brace and Team or a Special Award confined to one breed will not be considered to be a beaten dog.
- 12. BEST IN SHOW:** The dog declared Best in Show is a dog which has competed and is unbeaten by any other dog exhibited at the same Show.
- a. Shows Judged on the Group System:** (Definition; Shows judged on the Group System as defined in Kennel Club Regulation B(A); and require a judge to declare a Best of each Group after which the exhibits so declared will compete for the award of Best in Show and Reserve Best In Show).
- 1). BEST OF BREED:** Where a breed is separately classified a Best of Breed must be declared from those exhibits which have received an award. Where separate classes are provided for each sex of a breed a Best of each Sex must be selected from which the Best of Breed must be declared from those exhibits which have received an award.
- 2) BEST OF GROUP:** Best in Group must be selected from:
- (a) The Best of Breed winners in each group provided they are unbeaten winning dogs.
(b) The best unbeaten winning dog from the Any Variety Not Separately Classified classes.
(c) **Withdrawal from other Competition:** Dogs which become eligible for Best in Group and Best in Show may be withdrawn from all other competition other than breed classes and Best of Breed prior to the competition for Best of Group or Best in Show as appropriate in order to remain unbeaten. A dog beaten in competition for Best of Group or Best in Show may subsequently be exhibited in all competition for which it was previously eligible. The dogs declared Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show however, must not compete in any subsequent competition.
Dogs may be withdrawn from Any Variety Classes when judged before Breed Classes.
- Proviso:** For the purposes of this Regulation, dogs beaten in competition for Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Progeny, Brace and Team or a Special Award confined to a single breed, will not be considered to be beaten dogs.
- 13. EXHIBITS LATE FOR GROUP JUDGING:** Exhibits will not be admitted to Best in Show competition after a period of ten minutes has elapsed since the announcement that exhibits are required for judging, unless they have been unavoidably delayed by previous judging not being completed on time, and then only with the special permission of the Show Management.
- 14. SCHEDULE AMENDMENTS:** No modifications will be made to the schedule except by permission of the General Committee of The Kennel Club, which will be followed by advertisement in the Canine Press wherever possible.
- 15. F REGULATIONS:** All exhibitors must be familiar with Kennel Club Regulation F (Annex B) Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition.
- 16. OVERSEAS ENTRIES:** All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/ competitor.
- 17. DOGS IN CARS ON HOT DAYS:** Your dog is vulnerable and at risk during hot weather and the Kennel Club offers the following guidance to help guide you through the do's and don'ts travelling to and whilst at KC licensed events.
- When travelling to a show please take a moment to consider whether the route to the show is on a busy holiday route, and leave earlier to avoid increased time in traffic jams.
 - If your vehicle is not air conditioned seriously consider whether travelling to the show is a good idea at all.
 - The vehicle should be as fully ventilated as possible, and plenty of stops should be taken, with lots of water available to drink.
 - Ensure your dog is not sitting in full sunlight. There should be plenty of free flowing air around the dog.

Rules & Regs Contd.

17. Contd.

- When at a show, never leave your dog in the vehicle.
 - Keep the dog in the shade take your own shade for example a large umbrella and always have plenty of water available to drink so that your dog stays well hydrated.
 - Avoid your dog taking part in unnecessary exertion, or from standing in exposed sunlight for extended lengths of time.
 - Remember if you feel hot your dog is very likely to feel much hotter and dehydrated, and this could lead to dire results. Please look after your dog's welfare.
WARNING : IF YOUR DOG IS FOUND TO BE AT RISK FORCIBLE ENTRY TO YOUR VEHICLE MAY BE NECESSARY WITHOUT LIABILITY FOR ANY DAMAGE CAUSED.
Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.
- RIGHT TO REFUSE ENTRIES:** Exhibitors/Competitors are reminded that show societies have the right under Kennel Club Regulation to refuse any entry.
- 18. NOT FOR COMPETITION:** Not for competition entries will be accepted. Details of each dog so entered must be recorded on the entry form and must be Kennel Club registered.
- 19. ABIDE BY RULES:** Every Exhibitor making an entry or entries at this Show shall be deemed to have agreed to abide by the Kennel Club Rules and Show Regulations and by these Regulations and it is on this understanding only that entries are received.
- 20. RECEIPT OF ENTRIES:** All entries must be made on or before 26th February 2010 (postmark). In your own interests please use FIRST CLASS POST and if possible get Post Office proof of posting. If acknowledgement of entries is required, a stamped addressed postcard must be enclosed. Entries will not be received later than 8th March 2010 no matter what the date of the postmark is.
- 21. CORRECT FEES:** No entries will be accepted unless accompanied by the correct entrance fees payable in Sterling. Cheques to be made payable to the "NATIONAL TERRIER CLUB" in order for immediate payment.
- 22. EXHIBITORS PASSES:** Exhibitors will receive their passes which will admit one person for each dog entered. If passes have not been received five days before the Show, application should be made to the Show Printers Tel: 01858 433404.
- 23. UNENTERED ANIMALS:** No animal other than an exhibit duly entered at the show will be allowed within the precincts of the show during its continuance.
- 24. POWER TO REMOVE DOGS:** The Committee is empowered to exclude or to remove any dog which is not in a fit state for exhibition from disease, vice, natural or other causes. If such exclusion takes place either before or after the dog is judged, the entrance fee will be forfeited.
- 25. ACCOMPANIED DOGS:** All exhibits must be accompanied. The Committee cannot undertake to accept or despatch unaccompanied dogs. All dogs must have a suitable collar and lead properly fastened to the dog.
- 26. BENCHING:** No dog may be absent from its bench except for the purpose of being exercised for longer than 30 minutes. All breeds will be benched in catalogue order and the owner's dogs of the same breed will be benched consecutively, without extra fee. No bench numbers shall be changed from one pen to another and no dog and no dog shall be benched on any but its own numbered pen. Under no circumstances may partitions between the dogs be moved.
- 27. RESPONSIBILITY:** The Committee will be most anxious for the care and safety of the dogs brought for exhibition, but it must be distinctly understood by exhibitors and all other persons that the Committee will not be responsible for the loss, detention of, or damage to any dogs or omission of itself, its officers, agents, servants or others. The Committee will not be in any way responsible for any claim for injury or compensation occasioned by or arising out of the holding of the Show or by reason of the act or default of any person or persons in attendance or present there at.
Parents/adults will be held responsible for any damage caused by children in their care.
- 28. GANGWAYS AND GROOMING AREAS:** The majority of breeds have a 10 foot gangway between benches and as long as exhibitors make sure there is a 6 foot clear space in the middle, they will be able to groom their dogs on or at their bench. Grooming areas are also provided by the Club for those wishing to use them or unable to groom at the bench. The use of chalk powders or any other similar substance is prohibited within the precincts of the Show. See the KC regulations for the preparation of

dogs for exhibition F(B).

Rules & Regs Contd.

29. **JUDGES:** All judges are required to judge the classes in each breed in order in which they are entered in the judging book. Should any judge be prevented from fulfilling his/her engagement the Committee reserves to itself the right of appointing another in his/her place. Exhibitors are at liberty to withdraw from competition but no entrance fee can be refunded. Judges will be instructed and empowered to withhold the prize or prizes in any class if in their opinion the dog or dogs do not possess sufficient merit. Judges are not empowered to give prizes beyond those offered in this Schedule of Prizes. The Judges decision shall be final except in a case of fraud or misrepresentation or where a mistake has been made bone fide by the judge
30. **REGULATIONS:** All Rules and Regulations or definitions and instructions of the nature of rules and regulations printed for convenience in other parts of this Schedule shall be deemed to be Regulations of the Committee and shall have the same effect as if they formed part of these Regulations.
31. **RIGHT OF APPEAL:** Should any question arise not provided for in these Regulations the decision of the Committee shall be final, subject to appeal to the Kennel Club
32. **ENQUIRIES ETC:** All correspondence, enquiries and letters should be addressed to the Hon. Secretary and the breed exhibited mentioned.

All exhibitors attending the Show shall be responsible for all damage, loses, claims and expenses caused by or resulting from any acts or omissions of themselves and any child or children of theirs or children in his/her care, and shall fully indemnify the Club in respect of same.

ORDER OF JUDGING WILL BE SENT OUT WITH PASSES

DEFINITIONS OF CLASSES

PUPPIES UNDER SIX CALENDAR MONTHS OF AGE ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR EXHIBITION AT THIS SHOW/PUPPIES ENTERED NOT FOR COMPETITION MUST ALSO BE SIX CALENDAR MONTHS.

- In the following definitions a Challenge Certificate includes any Show award that counts towards the title of Champion under the Rules of any governing body recognised by The Kennel Club.
- Wins at Championship Shows in breed classes where Challenge Certificates are not on offer shall be counted as wins at Open Shows.
- In the case of a dog owned in partnership and entered in Members' classes or competing for Members' Specials each partner must at the time of entry be a member of the Club.
- In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including the seventh day before the date of closing of entries shall be counted when entering for any class i.e. (19th February 2010).
- Wins in Variety classes do not count for entry in Breed classes but when entering in Variety classes, wins in both Breed and Variety classes must be counted. A first prize does not include a Special Prize of whatever value.
- A dog is not eligible for entry in Variety Classes unless also entered and subsequently exhibited in a Breed class where such a class is provided for which it is eligible.
Exemptions from this Regulation are:
 - A puppy, unless a class for dogs under twelve months of age for which it is eligible is provided for the breed.
 - A dog in Any Variety Veteran Class
 - A dog which is withdrawn from exhibition in breed classes as a result of the appointment of an emergency judge.
 - A dog in the Y.K.C Stakes Classes.
- If an exhibitor reports before the judging of a class or classes that a dog has been entered which is ineligible, the exhibitor may choose one of the following options
 - Withdrawal:** The dog may be withdrawn from competition subject to the conditions of Regulations 9(j) and 20.
 - Transfer.**
 - If a dog is ineligible for a class or classes as regards its breed colour, sex, weight or height the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the equivalent class or classes for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height or, in the event of there being no equivalent class, Minor Puppy and Puppy excepted, to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.
 - For an exhibit entered incorrectly in a Minor Puppy class, Puppy class or Junior class, which is over age but under twelve calendar months of age, eighteen calendar months of age or twenty four calendar months of age respectively, the Show Secretary shall transfer the exhibit to the Puppy class, Junior class or Yearling class respectively for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height and in the event of there being no Puppy, Junior or Yearling class to the Open class for the correct, breed, colour, sex, weight or height.
 - For any reason other than the above, the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the Open Class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.
 - If an exhibit arrives late and misses a class, even if it is the only class in which the dog is entered, the dog may not be transferred to any other class.

MINOR PUPPY: For dogs of six and not exceeding nine calendar months of age on the first day of the show.

PUPPY: For dogs of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

JUNIOR: For dogs of six and not exceeding eighteen calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

NOVICE: For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or three or more First Prizes at Open and Championship Shows (Minor Puppy, Special Minor Puppy, Puppy and Special Puppy classes excepted, whether restricted or not).

Definitions Contd.

UNDERGRADUATE: For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or three or more First Prizes at Championship Shows (Minor Puppy, Special Minor Puppy, Puppy and Special Puppy classes excepted, whether restricted or not).

GRADUATE: For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or four or more First prizes at Championship Shows in Graduate, Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open Classes, whether restricted or not.

POST GRADUATE: For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or five or more First prizes at Championship Shows in Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open classes, whether restricted or not.

LIMIT: For dogs which have not become Show Champions under The Kennel Club Regulations or under the rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club or won seven or more First prizes in all, at Championship Shows in Limit or Open Classes, confined to the breed, whether restricted or not, at Shows where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

OPEN: For all dogs of the Breed for which the class is provided and eligible for entry at the Show.

NATIONAL TERRIER CLUB VETERAN STAKES:
For dogs of not less than 7 years of age on the first day of the Show.

NATIONAL TERRIER CLUB SPECIAL MEMBERS STAKES:
Confined to fully paid up Members of the National Terrier Club.

NATIONAL TERRIER CLUB SPECIAL BEGINNERS STAKES:
Exhibit not to have won a CC (UK) or CAC (Abroad) or 5 point Irish Green Star.

YKC STAKES: All pedigree dogs are eligible to take part provided the dog is registered on the Kennel Club Breed Register. The dog should be registered, either:

- a. Solely or jointly in the Member's name or
- b. In the name of a member of the family and under these circumstances the dog must be resident at the YK C Member's address.
 - No substitute handlers are permitted - the dog must be handled by the YKC member.
 - Members are not permitted to allow another individual to show their dog on their behalf if they are not able to attend the class.
 - Members must be aged 6 - 24 years (for members 6 years & up to, but not including 25th birthday)

PURINA PRO PLAN / DOG WORLD PUPPY STAKES:
Open to all puppies of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the show.
N.B. Dogs which have already qualified for the Purina Pro Plan / Dog World "Pup of the Year" final are not eligible to compete.

NOT FOR COMPETITION: Societies may at their discretion accept Not for Competition entries. Societies may accept such entries from breeds of dog not included within the title of the Society and at Shows held over more than one day, such entries may be accepted on any day from any breed. Dogs **MUST** be at least **SIX** calendar months of age on the day of the Show

REGULATIONS FOR THE PREPARATIONS OF DOGS F OR EXHIBITION F (B)

1. These regulations must be observed when a dog is prepared for exhibition and/or exhibited at any Kennel Club Licensed event. Objections may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under these show regulations and/or for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rule A42.(a) A dog found to have been exhibited in breach of these regulations will automatically be disqualified from exhibition at the show and from any award gained there. (b) Unless the exhibitor provides a satisfactory explanation for the dog being exhibited in breach of these regulations, he/she may be subject to further penalties of either a fine or as listed under rule A42.
2. (a) No substance which alters the natural colour, texture or body of the coat may be present in the dog's coat for any purpose at any time during the show. No substance which alters the natural colour of any external part of the dog may be present on the dog for any purpose at any time during the show. (b) Any other substance (other than water) which may be used in the preparation of a dog for exhibition must not be allowed to remain in the coat or an any other part of the dog at the time of exhibition.
3. No act or operation which alters the natural conformation of a dog or any part thereof may be performed except:
(a) Operations certified to the satisfaction of the General Committee. (b) The removal of dewclaws of any breed (c) Operations to prevent breeding provided such operations are notified to the Kennel Club before neutered dogs are shown. Nor must anything be done calculated to in the opinion of the General Committee to deceive.
4. The General Committee without previous notice may order an examination of any dog or dogs at any Show. Any examination thus ordered will be made by a person having executive authority who shall have a written directive from the Kennel Club in their possession. Samples may be taken for further examination & analysis.
5. An individual has the right to lodge an objection to a dog only if he/she is the owner or handler of a dog competing in the same breed or class. An objection may, however, be lodged by any official of the Show or by anyone so deputed by the Kennel Club. It will be the responsibility of the individual who lodges the objection or the official (as appropriate), to substantiate the grounds for the objection. The Kennel Club will substantiate the grounds for an objection made on its behalf.
6. Any objection by an individual related to an infringement of these regulations must be made in writing to the Show Secretary at his/her office before the close of the Show & the individual must produce evidence of identity at the time of lodging the complaint.

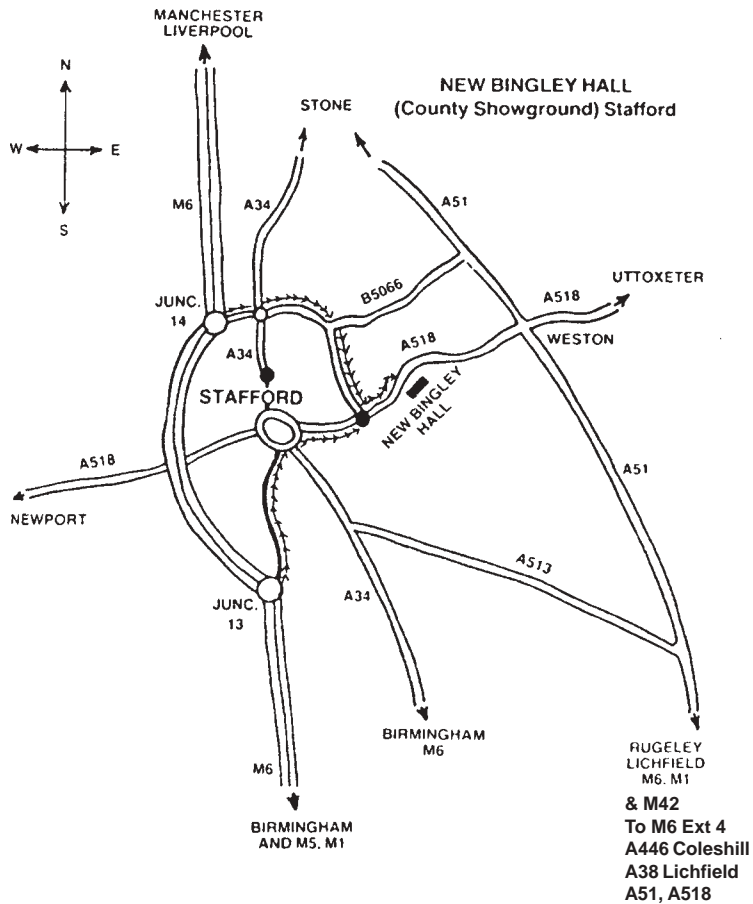


The following requirements apply to entries for these awards:

1. Breeders wishing to enter the competition should first purchase a Breeders Competition Record Book from the Kennel Club or from the show secretary.
2. The Breeder enters for the award in his/her name and is responsible for arranging which exhibits form their breeder group, or team
3. The Breeder must complete the Record Book accurately with all necessary details before presenting it to the show organisers.
4. The Breeder is responsible for obtaining the necessary authority to compete from the show organisers (or designated official such as the Ring Steward) to compete for the award.
5. The Breeder's team must comprise four exhibits of the same breed, all of which must be entered in a class at the show.
6. A Breeder may enter more than one team per show.
7. All dogs must have the same registered breeder.
8. The 'beaten dog' rule will NOT apply.
9. Best Breeder in Breed goes through to a Best Breeder in Group award.
10. Twenty points are required to qualify for Finals at Crufts in the following year. Points are cumulative over a calendar year and are gained as follows:
 Breed win 1 point Fourth in Group 1 point Third in Group 2 points
 Second in Group 3 points First in Group 4 points

Breeders gaining 20 points should apply to the Canine Activities Department at the Kennel Club to apply for the Crufts Final. After amassing 20 points a breeder cannot enter any further Best Breeder Competitions for that calendar year.
